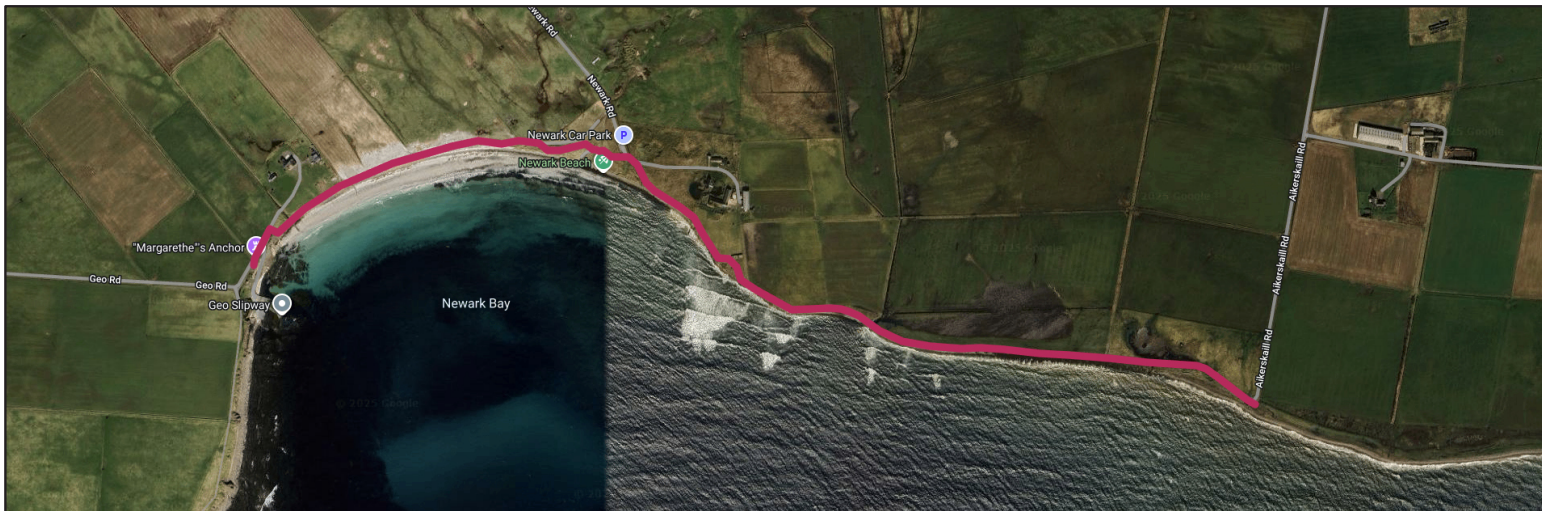
Friday and Saturday have an extra bus leaving Kirkwall at 2203 (Fri from Picky at 2200) and returns from Lighthouse corner at 2232
